

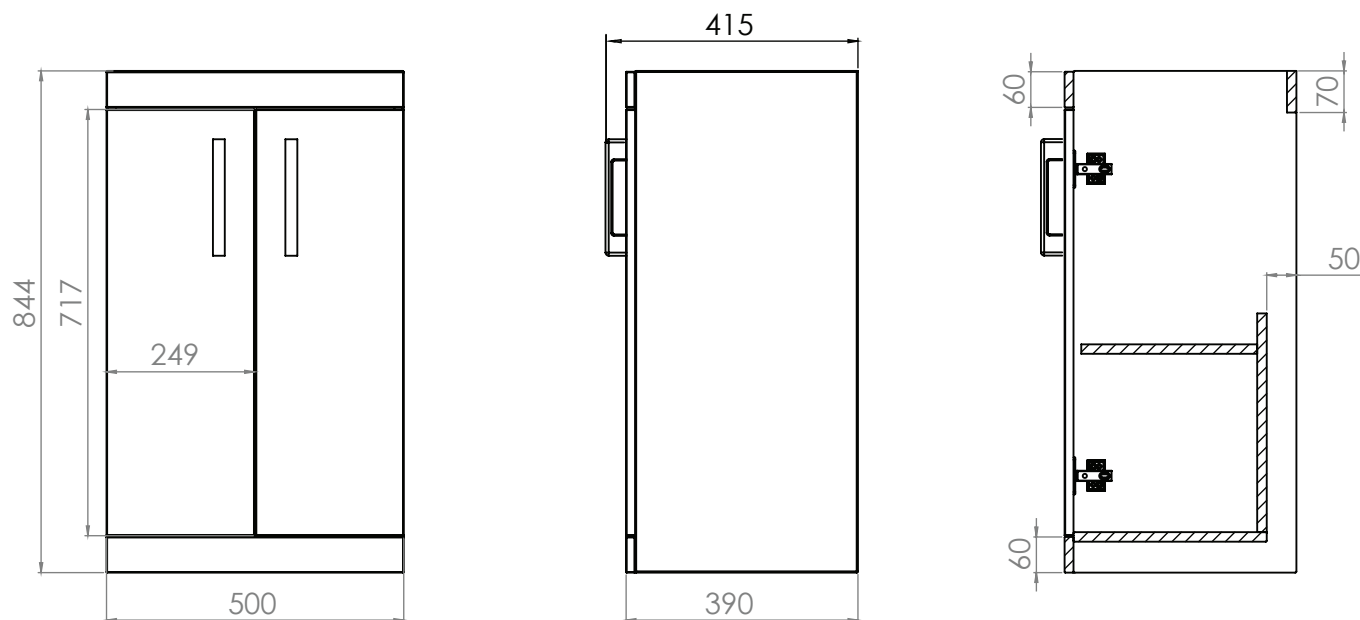

Materials

Fascia Components: 16mm painted MDF

FAQs

Q: How big is the plumbing void at the back of the furniture?

A: 50mm.

Q: Are the handles fitted?

A: No, handles require fitting. Unit comes with pilot holes drilled on back face. Chrome 128mm centre handle included with fixings

Q: Is the door reversible?

A: Yes, the door has equal spaced hinges for door reversibility.

Q: How deep/wide is the unit with doors open?

A: Approx depth with 90-degree hinge 645mm.

Q: Is the shelf removable?

A: No, the shelf is fixed.

Q: What is the shelf capacity?

A: Shelf depth: 315mm

Q: How many shelves are there?

A: One internal shelf.

Q: What is the internal finish of the unit?

A: Dark grey internal finish on all finishes.

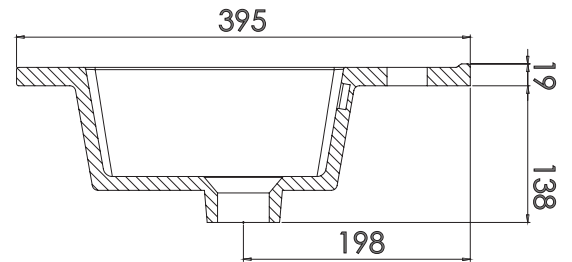
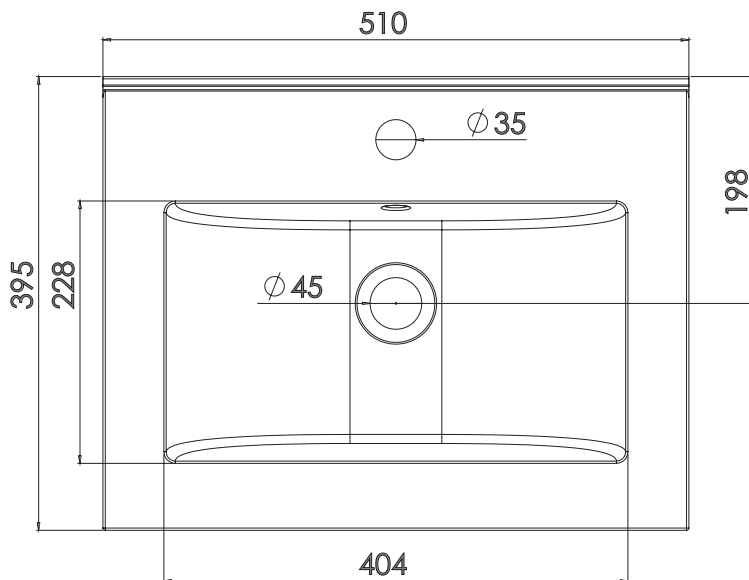

FAQs

Q: What is the maximum water depth of the basin?

A: 93mm up to the overflow.

Q: What is the internal depth?

A: The internal depth is 132mm.

Q: What is the depth of the tapledge?

A: The tapledge is 115mm deep.

Q: What is the distance from the taphole centre to basin waste?

A: 130mm

Q: What is the overflow rating?

A: Overflow rating is CL10
